PacifiCorp dba Rocky Mountain Power (“Rocky Mountain Power” or “the Company”) hereby submits its reply comments in the above referenced Notice of Proposed Rule Amendment.

The Company notes that parties submitting comments in this docket generally support an amendment to R746-100-3 that encourages electronic filings and a reduction in the requirements for paper copies to simplify filing and service requirements.

In its comments of May 24, 2016 the Company requested that the Commission schedule a workshop for interested parties to discuss how a website might be used for filing of confidential and non-confidential materials in proceedings, including discovery. The Company hereby repeats its request for a workshop wherein interested parties may work to achieve a joint recommendation to the Commission for amendments to R746-100-3.

Participants in the workshop may address issues including but not limited to the following:

- Under what circumstances electronic filings may be considered timely.
- Under what circumstances electronic filings may be considered timely when followed up with limited copies.
- The format of electronic filings.
- The treatment of confidential information electronically filed.
- How electronic filings may facilitate the State requirement that outside media be scanned.
- The potential establishment of a secure website that may be used for filing of confidential and non-confidential pleadings.
