Dear Mr. Taylor:

On March 31, 2014, PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power filed its 2013 Annual Report of the Blue Sky Program (Report) with the Public Service Commission of Utah (Commission). Comments on the Report were provided by the Utah Division of Public Utilities (Division) in a memorandum dated May 14, 2014 (Division Memorandum). The Commission appreciates these comments.

The Division notes the Report contains an inconsistency in the ending and starting available fund balances between the 2012 and 2013 Annual Reports, respectively. In response to a Division data request PacifiCorp provided clarification for these inconsistencies. The Division reports that with

the additional information it was able to balance the accounts across the two years and provides a corrected statement of funding balances. The Division concludes the Report, with the funding corrections noted in the Division Memorandum, is in compliance with Commission Orders and adheres to the Commission's reporting requirements.

The Division notes the 2012 Blue Sky Annual Report also had beginning and ending balance inconsistencies and recommends the Commission require PacifiCorp to include all necessary information in future annual reports to enable the reader of the future reports to track the ending and beginning balances across the relevant years. With that addition the Division recommends the Commission acknowledge the Report as meeting the requirements of the Commission. The Commission has reviewed PacifiCorp's Report and the Division's recommendations. The Commission acknowledges the Report, as corrected in the Division's Memorandum, complies with prior Commission orders and directives. The Commission further directs PacifiCorp to incorporate the Division's recommendations that PacifiCorp provide all necessary information to reconcile the beginning and ending available fund balances in future annual reports on the Blue Sky Program.
