By the Commission:

On March 5, 2002, PacifiCorp's Application To Initiate Investigation of Inter-jurisdictional Issues was filed with the Commission and served electronically on all persons on our service list for Energy matters and for Docket Nos. 01-035-01 and 01-035-15. The Application requested that the Commission issue a notice inviting written or oral comments on the Application no later than March 22, 2002 so that the multistate process ("MSP") proposed in the Application may move forward on an expeditious basis. The Application suggested that parties wishing to participate in the MSP notify PacifiCorp as soon as practicable so that they may be included on an MSP distribution list. The Application stated that PacifiCorp would nominate a Special Master to conduct the proposed MSP process by March 15, 2002 and suggested that states give notice to PacifiCorp prior to March 29, 2002 if they object to the Special Master. The Application requested that interested parties forward to PacifiCorp any briefing papers or any other information they wish to be reviewed by the Special Master prior to the MSP not later than April 5, 2002.

Based on the foregoing and good cause appearing, you are hereby given notice of the Application. You are invited to:

1. Submit comments on the Application by March 22, 2002. Following review of comments submitted, the Commission may issue an order initiating the investigation and establishing a multistate process in connection with the investigation.

2. Notify PacifiCorp as soon as practicable if you wish to participate in the MSP by e-mail (Sue.Rolfe@PacifiCorp.com) or mail (Sue Rolfe, PacifiCorp, Suite 300, 825 NE Multnomah, Portland Oregon 97232).

3. Notify the Division of Public Utilities as soon as practicable, but in any event not later than March 26, 2002, if you object to the Special Master proposed by PacifiCorp to conduct the MSP. By this Notice, the Commission directs the Division of Public Utilities to compile any objections to the proposed Special Master, to coordinate with Utah stakeholders to determine whether an objection should be made and to report the results of this coordination to the Commission by not later than March 28, 2002.

4. Forward to PacifiCorp any briefing papers or any other information that you wish to have the Special Master review in advance of the MSP by April 5, 2002.
