Wasatch Wind requests an extension of time for filing its surrebuttal testimony in this docket. On August 10th the Commission issued an order that extended by four days the due date for rebuttal testimony of intervening parties to Wasatch Wind's direct testimony. This extension was granted as a result of an inadvertent late filing of the electronic copy of Wasatch Wind's direct testimony. Rebuttal testimony for Wasatch Wind is due on September 12, 2005 rather than September 8th. This creates a problem for Wasatch Wind. Surrebuttal testimony is due on September 15, 2005 giving Wasatch Wind just three days to prepare its response to rebuttal testimony. Other parties will get a full seven days to prepare their surrebuttal response. This will put Wasatch Wind at disadvantage and could affect quality of the testimony presented to the Commission. Wasatch Wind requests an extension of two business days for its filing of surrebuttal testimony or a filing date of September 19, 2005. This slight delay should not affect the rest of the schedule for this proceeding. Wasatch Wind requests prompt Commission's approval of this request.
