By Expedited Motion to Revise the Schedule for Response to the Motion to Dismiss, filed May 18, 2006, the Division of Public Utilities and the Committee of Consumer Services requested additional time to respond to the Motion to Dismiss Pacificorp's Application for approval of a Power Cost Adjustment Mechanism (PCAM), filed May 10, 2006, by the Utah Industrial Energy Consumers (UIEC). They request an extension such that Responses to the Motion to Dismiss, currently due on May 24, 2006, may be filed on June 9 and Replies, currently due on June 5, 2006, may be filed on June 23, 2006. They state that UIEC has agreed to the extension and that they believe that no party will be prejudiced by the extension.
