By the Commission:

By Motion submitted October 2, 2007, Pacificorp requested permission to amend its Request for Proposals for a generating resource previously filed March 26, 2007 and approved by the Commission on April 4, 2007. Pacificorp filed a supporting memorandum October 16, 2007, which provides information concerning the reasons Pacificorp seeks to amend and the amendments proposed. The supporting memorandum was submitted pursuant to the additional protective terms provided in our Revised Protective Order issued in this docket. The Motion requests Commission authorization to amend the 2012 request for proposals with respect to the following: (1) to modify the schedule in Section 2, whereby the proposal response date would change from June 19, 2007 to January 18, 2008, permitting new and existing bidders an opportunity to submit new bids or refresh their existing bids; (2) to eliminate the upfront request for qualifications procedure and instead, require submission of an intent to bid form; to modify the qualification requirements so that new bidders will be required to submit qualification appendices with their bids and existing bidders will only need to update qualification appendices if information has changed; and to only require bidders (new and existing) to post acceptable commitment letters or letters of credit within ten business days following notification of their

selection to the initial shortlist; and (3) to update the 2012 benchmark resources by including resources located at the existing Lake Side site and/or existing Currant Creek site. No responses to the Motion have been submitted and the Commission gives this notice setting a filing deadline for any responses to the October 2, 2007, Motion and a hearing date, reserved to address any disputes that may arise on whether the October 2, 2007, Motion should be granted and the Request for Proposals be amended as requested by Pacificorp. Because of the need to timely proceed with the procurement of the needed generating resource and the process to obtain it, the Commission will set this matter on an expedited schedule

Wherefore, the Commission requires any interested person who wishes to respond to the October 2, 2007, Motion to file and serve a written response on or before November 2, 2007. The Commission will hold a hearing on the Motion if any objections are raised, otherwise the Commission will proceed pursuant to Utah Administrative Rule 746-100-4. D. If objection is made, the Commission will conduct a hearing on **November 7, 2007, at 10:00 a.m.** in Room 403, 4th Floor of the Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.
