Dear Mr. Larsen,

The Public Service Commission of Utah is in receipt of your January 22, 2008, memorandum regarding a change to General Commitment 34 C, as agreed pursuant to the Commission's approval of the acquisition of PacifiCorp by MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company ("MEHC"), whereby MEHC has determined the proposed Walla Walla – Yakima/Mid C transmission system infrastructure improvement project (the "Yakima Project") is not economically feasible. In the alternative, MEHC and PacifiCorp propose two new transmission projects: Walla Walla to McNary (the "McNary Project") and Vantage to Pomona Heights (the "Vantage Project"), as described more fully in your memorandum.

On March 24, 2008, the Utah Division of Public Utilities filed a memorandum detailing its review of your proposal and recommending the Commission take no further action regarding the substitution of the McNary Project and Vantage Project for the Yakima Project, except that the Commission instruct PacifiCorp to retain all analysis regarding the proposed Yakima Project and the substitute projects for future prudence and cost recovery review.

By this letter, the Commission acknowledges receipt of your filing of January 22, 2008, as well as the Division's recommendation, and hereby instructs PacifiCorp to retain all information regarding this issue as recommended by the Division. The Commission contemplates no further action on this issue at this time.
