This letter is in response to an inquiry to Rea Petersen at the Division of Public Utilities. In your inquiry, you stated that at the February 22,2007 technical conference in the above docket, Rocky Mountain Power agreed to inform you how much additional load would be available to you. Our records indicate that the company indicated that we could provide information regarding whether existing facilities could accommodate a specific amount of additional load. At the technical conference you mentioned an additional load of 100 HP. However, on February 27,2007, Rocky Mountain Power received a different request from your spouse asking for an additional 200 to 700 HP of additional load. At this point you were asked to put your specific request for additional load in writing to avoid any confusion.

Rocky Mountain Power's records indicate that you submitted a completed load sheet on March 29, 2007 requesting 200 HP of additional load. An estimate is currently being prepared for this additional load and will be provided to you no later than April 19, 2007, provided that all necessary information to process this request has been received.
