By Scheduling Order issued April 4, 2006, the Commission set a procedural schedule for these proceedings, setting forth separate schedules for resolution of test period issues, revenue requirement issues and cost of service/rate design issues. Subsequently, we have modified the schedule for the test period issues through two additional scheduling orders. Our April 4, 2006, Order also inferred a schedule for Commission Docket No. 05-035-102, by including that docket's subject matter, a power cost adjustment mechanism, in the heading used for the revenue requirement procedural schedule, although no corresponding scheduling order or procedural notice was issued in Docket No. 05-035-102. The April 4, 2006, Order also consolidated, for specified, limited purposes, Docket Nos. 06-035-21 and 05-035-102. In Docket No. 05-035-102, a Motion to Dismiss has been filed and the Commission has issued a procedural order in that docket to address the Motion to Dismiss. Because of the changes already made to the schedule and developments in Docket No. 05-035-102, the Commission concludes that portions of the April 4, 2006, Order should be vacated. The perceived benefits from consolidation are no longer relevant and each case may proceed independently.

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Wherefore, the Commission issues this ORDER vacating:

- 1. Those portions of the April 4, 2006, Scheduling Order which set a procedural schedule for the test year issues in Docket 06-035-21,
- 2. Those portions which set a procedural schedule for the filing of testimony and evidentiary hearings for Docket No. 05-035-102, and
 - 3. Those portions which consolidated Docket Nos. 06-035-21 and 05-035-102.
