Surrebuttal Testimony of Andrea Coon  
Division of Public Utilities

June 14, 2006

1 **Q. Please state your name and the party you represent.**

2 A. My name is Andrea Coon. I represent the Division of Public Utilities  
3 (Division).

5 **Q. Have you previously filed testimony in this matter?**

6 A. Yes. I filed rebuttal testimony on May 31, 2006.

7 **Q. What is the purpose of this Surrebuttal testimony?**

8 A. Although no other parties have filed testimony since the Division filed on  
9 May 31<sup>st</sup>, Wasatch Wind and PacifiCorp filed a position matrix that outlined  
10 areas of dispute between them. The purpose of this testimony is to provide the  
11 Commission with the Division's current positions on the disputed issues.

12 **Q. What is the method by which the Division will be presenting its positions  
13 on the disputed issues?**

14 A. The Division has taken the matrix provided by Wasatch Wind as well as  
15 supplemental information provided by PacifiCorp and simply added a column  
16 to the far right that outlines the Division's position on each issue. This matrix  
17 is attached as Division Exhibit 1.1SR.

18 **Q. Does the Division have any other comments to make regarding its  
19 position statements in the matrix?**

20 A. Many of the disputed issues have not been explicitly addressed in testimony  
21 up to this point, so the positions of the Division are initial positions. These  
22 initial positions are based upon the Division's belief that it is a developer's  
23 responsibility to bear the risks associated with their project, not the  
24 responsibility of either PacifiCorp or its ratepayers. The Division may choose

25 to alter its positions as it receives more information as to the specific reasons  
26 behind the disputed conditions.

27 **Q. Does this conclude your testimony at this time?**
