By The Commission:

On October 26, 2007, the Commission issued its Revised Scheduling Order establishing various procedural deadlines in this matter, including hearing dates of January 15-17, 2008.

On December 7, 2007, Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”) filed an Unopposed Motion to Amend Revised Scheduling Order (“Motion”) seeking to extend to December 21, 2007, the December 14, 2007, deadline for filing of surrebuttal testimony established by the Revised Scheduling Order. The Motion states the Division of Public Utilities, the Committee of Consumer Services, and the Utah Association of Energy Users (hereinafter jointly referred to with RMP as the “Parties”) do not oppose the Motion as several of the Parties continue to engage in settlement negotiations.

On December 17, 2007, Commission staff verbally notified counsel for RMP that the Commission had decided to grant the Motion and that Commission order memorializing said decision would follow.

On December 18, 2007, counsel for RMP contacted Commission staff by telephone and requested the Commission vacate the current procedural schedule, except for the

scheduled to convene January 15, 2008, to permit Parties to continue their negotiations toward settlement of all outstanding issues in this docket. Counsel for RMP stated all Parties concur in the request to vacate.

Wherefore, based upon the foregoing and for good cause appearing, the procedural schedule established by the Revised Scheduling Order is hereby vacated, except for that portion setting hearings to commence on January 15, 2008.
