Dear Commissioners:

Please find attached the application of PacifiCorp, doing business as Rocky Mountain Power (the Company), in the named matter requesting an order of the Commission granting an exemption from the requirements of Subsection 54-4-31(1) of the Utah Code Annotated pursuant to Subsection 54-4-31(4) thereof. An original and 15 copies are attached hereto.

The Commission previously granted such an exemption to the Company in Docket Nos. 98-2035-02 and 00-035-16, copies of which are attached as Exhibit A to the application. However, in connection with the Commission's approval of the acquisition by MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company in Docket No. 05-035-4, the Commission required the Company to apply for approval of securities issuances, but agreed that the Company could seek a waiver of that requirement 12 months after the closing of the acquisition. (See Exhibit B to the application for a copy of Commitment U12.) The acquisition closed on March 21, 2006.

The Company continues to believe that the proposed exemption will reduce administrative burdens on the Commission, its Staff and the Company without adversely affecting the flow of information to the Commission concerning the Company's securities transactions. No concerns have arisen subsequent to the acquisition by MidAmerican Energy Holdings Company to indicate that the exemption is inappropriate. In addition, the exemption will have no effect on any utility rate-making issues and the Commission will retain its ability to determine the appropriate regulatory treatment of the Company's securities transactions in subsequent proceedings. Accordingly, the application of Subsection 54-4-31(1) of the Utah Code continues not to be required in the public interest.

The Company respectfully requests the Commission's action on this issue by April 30, 2007. The Company requests twelve (12) copies of any order issued in this matter.
