On March 31, 2009, Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP") submitted a motion to set schedule. Parties have had an opportunity to respond to the motion and the Commission has considered the motion and responses. Being fully advised and based upon good cause, the Commission orders the following schedule and procedures to govern further proceedings in this docket, unless later modified by the Commission:

- 2. All hearings and the status and scheduling conference in the foregoing schedule, with the exception of the Public Witness Hearing, shall be held at the Heber M. Wells State Office Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah, and shall commence at 9:30 a.m. and shall continue thereafter as directed by the Commission. Hearings shall be held in Room 451, and the Status and Scheduling Conference shall be held in Room 401.
- Citizen's Center Auditorium, 465 East 1200 South, Heber City, Utah 84032 and shall commence at 4:30 p.m. and conclude at 5:30 p.m. unless all individuals wishing to present public witness testimony cannot be heard by 5:30 p.m., in which event the hearing shall continue until all persons who have signed in to present public witness testimony that is not unduly repetitive of testimony already presented have had an opportunity to do so. Individuals wishing to present sworn or unsworn testimony to the Commission during the Public Witness Hearing are encouraged to sign in with a representative of the Committee of Consumer Services at the Public Witness Hearing by 4:25 p.m. if possible and must sign-in not later than 5:25 p.m. The Commission encourages individuals to present brief statements of their position and individuals with similar positions to coordinate their statements to avoid undue repetition. Individuals may elect to present

sworn or unsworn testimony. If individuals elect to present sworn testimony, the Commission may base a finding on their testimony, but they will be subject to cross examination. If individuals elect to present unsworn testimony, the Commission may not base a finding solely on their testimony, but they will not be subject to cross examination. Any individual wishing to present a statement of position to the Commission that is unable to do so during the Public Witness Hearing may file a written statement of position with the Commission at its offices, Fourth Floor, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah 84114 in person, by mail, by electronic mail to mlivingston@utah.gov or by facsimile to (801) 530-6796. Written statements of position shall be treated in the same manner as unsworn public witness testimony.

- 4. RMP shall publish notice of the Public Witness Hearing twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the Wasatch County area in advance of the Public Witness Hearing.
- 5. Responses to discovery requests for depositions and for written discovery not directed to filed testimony, shall be provided in accordance with the time frames established by the Utah Rules of Civil Procedure. Responses to written discovery requests addressed to testimony served thereafter shall be provided within 14 calendar days. Parties serving discovery requests and responding to the requests may mutually agree to shorten or extend the foregoing time frames.
- 6. Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail at or before the time an electronic copy of the document is filed with the

Commission. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document filed with the Commission or produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party filing the document shall file an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) to the Commission by hand delivery and shall serve an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) on applicable parties by hand delivery if the parties are in the same city or by overnight courier if the parties are located in different cities.

- 7. Individuals wishing to participate in a hearing or conference by telephone should contact the Public Service Commission two days in advance by calling (801) 530- 6716 or call toll-free 1-866-PSC-UTAH (1-866-772-8824). Participants attending by telephone should then call the Public Service Commission five minutes prior to the hearing or conference to ensure participation.
- 8.
