- 9 regarding Dues and Membership fees.

- 12 A. Mr. McDougal's Rebuttal Testimony line 467 states that "documentation was obtained to
- support the fees for both WECC and EPRI." DPU Data Request number 51 was sent to the
- 14 Company on May 12, 2008 requesting the referenced supporting documentation as well as
- schedule 11.15.2 which was missing from Mr. McDougal's Rebuttal Testimony. On May 15,
- 16 2008 the Company provided the missing invoices to substantiate the EPRI Dues and
- Membership fees included in the Company's testimony. The Company also provided the
- WECC invoice dated February 21, 2007 verifying Dues and Membership fees paid to
- 19 WECC.
- 20 O. Based on the results of your investigation, what adjustment should be made to Dues
- 21 and Membership fees?

- A. My review indicates that WECC dues were accrued on the Company's books in excess of the
- annual invoice amount. I agree with Mr. McDougal's adjustment to remove \$95,716 of

- on new supporting documentation supplied by the Company.
