Dear Mr. Moench,

It has come to the Commission's attention, there may be some confusion regarding certain requirements in PacifiCorp's 2008 All Source RFP approved in Docket No. 07-035-94. Specifically, as a condition of approval, the Commission required in its September 25, 2008, order, the Company convene a work group to review and make recommendations regarding (i) the mechanism to be used to compare alternative portfolios; and, (ii) the criteria to be used for selecting final shortlist resources from the highest performing portfolios; further, the Company will report its conclusions regarding the foregoing issues to the Commission prior to evaluating any bids under this All Source RFP.

It is our understanding the Company has yet to convene this workgroup and bids are due December 16, 2008. The confusion appears to lie in what constitutes "prior to evaluating any bids" and consequently, when the Company's report is due to the Commission. By this letter, we wish to inform the Company, it is our expectation bid evaluation begins with the activities listed in the RFP, Section 6. "Bid Evaluation Process of the Proposals." We encourage the Company to ensure timely formation of the workgroup and timely completion of the report so as to ensure adequate time for bid evaluation, which is scheduled for completion February 27, 2009, and to ensure against unnecessary delay in the RFP process.
