Pursuant to the technical conference held November 2, 2009, Rocky Mountain Power hereby submits for filing an original and five (5) copies of its Proposed Final Short List Development for the All Source Request for Proposals. The attached includes updates to the information that was included and proposed in a letter filed with the Public Service Commission January 5, 2009.

The Commission staff requested that the Company provide comments as part of the filing on the 200 megawatt east side power purchase agreement starting in 2012. Currently there is existing merchant generation on the east side available for contracting. The Company has been and will continue to pursue the 200 megawatt resource on a bilateral basis from existing generation resources for a term of less than ten years. The 200 megawatt resource will remain as a proxy resource in the analysis and will not be replaced with the resources from the All Source. Bidders in the All Source request for proposal may provide proposal(s) commencing prior to 2014.
