Solar Incentive Program – Request for Time Extension

REOUEST

The Division of Public Utilities (Division) requests an extension of time of approximately 45 days to fully evaluate the filing, Rocky Mountain Power's proposed Solar Incentive program, Docket Number 07-035-T14. The original filing was submitted on April 4, 2007, with the Division's response due to the Commission on April 26, 2007.

ISSUE

The Division is concerned that the current filing lacks sufficient information regarding program cost-effectiveness or other justifications, and long-term objectives. On April 19, 2007, Division and Committee of Consumer Services (CCS) staff met with Company and Utah Clean Energy representatives to discuss questions and concerns about the program. The Company agreed to conduct additional analysis to address Division and CCS issues raised at this meeting. It is



estimated that an additional 45 days will be needed for the Company to complete this effort. It is anticipated that the proposed program will be re-filed in mid-June once the additional analysis is complete. The Division therefore requests that the Commission extend the deadline for review of this program, and will respond promptly to the revised filing.
