Three Year Assessment Report

In its August 3, 2007 order in Docket No. 07-035-T14, the Public Service Commission of Utah (the "Commission") directed Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") to "provide a report within three years assessing whether changes are warranted in any element of the Program" at page 8. The Company is currently working on the ordered report, including compiling data and performing the analysis necessary to make the assessment directed in the order. The Company, however, anticipates it will take up to an additional 60 days to complete the analysis. As such, the Company requests that the Commission grant an extension for filing of the assessment report to September 30, 2010.
