My name is Steven Wright and I live in Sandy, Utah and I am seriously considering purchasing a 0.9 kW solar PV system (one quarter of my electrical usage) this year. I strongly recommend this program not only to be continued but to be expanded. At \$1.55/W I would receive about \$1400 with this program. This would go toward paying the \$6500 estimate given by the vendor.

Without this program the probability that I would be able to afford it is greatly diminished. Moreover, the chances that I would expand my home PV solar power capacity in the future to eventually achieve a 100% electric power production would also be greatly reduced if this program would not continue for several years in the future.

I would like to thank Rocky Mountain Power and the Commission for their work to date on the pilot solar program and for this opportunity to give my opinion.
