Dear Commisioners,

I am writing in reference to Docket No. 07-035-T14, Rocky Mountain Power's Solar Incentive Program. I am a 35 year resident of Utah at the same address.

I think the Solar Incentive program should be expanded, not disbanded, RMP talks about increasing demands for electricity, including the construction of EXPENSIVE new generating plants.
