Based on the information presented by interested persons and the discussion at the October 7, 2007, Scheduling Conference held in this docket, the Commission makes the following order regarding the schedule in this docket dealing with the general rate case application submitted by Pacificorp (the Company) on July 17, 2008, and supplemented September 10, 2008.
