On April 21, 2008, the Commission issued an Order requesting comments on the report entitled "Assessment of Long-Term System-Wide Potential for Demand-Side and Other Supplemental Resources" ("DSM Potential Report") prepared for PacifiCorp ("Company") by the Quantec consulting group. This report was released on July 11, 2007, and was prepared by MidAmerican Energy Holding Company and PacifiCorp to comply with Transaction Commitment No. 44(a), Energy Efficiency and DSM Management, approved in Docket No.05-035-54. The Order set June 27, 2008, as the deadline for parties to file comments and specifically requested comments from interested parties including comments on the use of the DSM Potential Report for DSM evaluation at both the planning and program approval stages of DSM program analysis and how well the report fulfills the required commitment criteria.

On June 19, 2008, the Division filed a memorandum with the Commission requesting an extension of time to file comments, a multiple round process of revising the existing report, a requirement that Pacificorp formally file the revised report, and a final regulatory review of the revised report. The Division provided the following suggested process and schedule for Commission consideration.

- July 18, 2008 Interested parties submit initial comments to the Company;
- August 13, 2008 A Technical Conference is held to discuss and respond to comments;
- August 29, 2008 The Company officially files the DSM Potential Report based on input from the Technical Conference;
- Sept 12, 2008 Formal comments on the document are due to the Commission.

The Division represented to Commission staff that parties to the Docket had been contacted regarding the proposed process and schedule and there were no objections to its adoption.
