MOTION OF ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DSM POTENTIAL REPORT

Rocky Mountain Power, a division of PacifiCorp, ("Rocky Mountain Power" or "PacifiCorp"), hereby moves the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") for an extension of time to file the Assessment of Long-Term System-Wide Potential for Demand-Side and Other Supplemental Resources report. In support of this Motion, Rocky Mountain Power states as follows:

1. On October 24, 2007, the Utah Division of Public Utilities ("Division") recommended the Commission consider a formal regulatory review process to address comments and issues on the report entitled "Assessment of Long-Term System-Wide Potential for Demand-Side and Other Supplemental Resources" ("DSM Potential Report") prepared for PacifiCorp by the Quantec consulting group. This report was released on July 11, 2007, and was prepared to meet MidAmerican Energy Holding

Company and PacifiCorp compliance with Transaction Commitment No. 44(a), Energy Efficiency and DSM Management, approved in Docket No.05-035-54.

- 2. On April 21, 2008, the Commission issued an Order establishing June 27, 2008 as the deadline for the Division and other interested parties to file comments on the DSM Potential Report.
- 3. On June 19, 2008, the Division requested that the Commission extend the deadline for comments on the DSM Potential Report. The Division also recommended that the Company be given some time to respond to those comments, and that the Commission hold a Technical Conference prior to the DSM Potential Report being formally filed with the Commission.
- 4. On June 27, 2008, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in this Docket establishing dates for comments and a Technical Conference, and requiring the Company to file the DSM Potential Report with the Commission on August 29, 2008.
- 5. The Company is currently working to make select clarifications within the DSM Potential Report based on input received at the Technical Conference. The Company is also working to complete written responses to several stated questions provided by interested parties and will include these responses in the filing. To complete the work necessary for this filing, the Company respectfully requests an extension in the filing schedule from August 29, 2008 to September 15, 2008. Granting an extension of time of approximately two weeks will allow the Company to better manage the work required for the filing and ensure all relevant issues raised at the Technical Conference are adequately addressed in the filing.

WHEREFORE, PacifiCorp respectfully requests an extension of time to file the DSM Potential Report until September 15, 2008, and a corresponding extension of time for formal comments on the DSM Potential Report until September 29, 2008.
