Rocky Mountain Power is proposing changes to its Schedule 135 to make it consistent with requirements sets forth in Utah's recently passed Senate Bill 88. The proposed changes to Schedule 135 expand the maximum allowed capacity for non-residential customers, expand the type from inverter only to include switchgear, increase the current capacity of all generators, expand the type of qualified net metering facilities and clarify how unused generation credits expire. For informational purposes, the Company is also providing its residential and commercial interconnection agreements which set forth the interconnection requirements for net metering customers.
