By The Commission:

A duly noticed Scheduling Conference was held July 14, 2009 in this matter. Parties discussed a schedule, discovery procedures and the pending motion of the Utah Industrial Energy Consumers to bifurcate the case. Contemporaneously with the issuance of this Scheduling Order, the Commission is issuing an order on the bifurcation issue and a scheduling order for Docket No. 09-035-15, In the Matter of the Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of its Proposed Energy Cost Adjustment Mechanism. Due to our resolution of the bifurcation request, our effort to accommodate the Commission's own schedule and the work-load of the Commission and parties participating in this docket and Docket No. 09-035-15, the Commission issues this Scheduling Order, which varies in some respects from the schedule discussed at the July 14, 2009, Scheduling Conference. The Commission will address rate of return, revenue requirement, and cost of service aspects of this case in Phase I and will address final rate design in Phase II. Although the Commission has included in this scheduling order the Phase II schedule outlined at the July 14, 2009, Scheduling Conference, the Commission recognizes that the dates proposed anticipated hearings for Phase II Rate Design matters at an earlier time than they will likely be addressed in light of our decision on the bifurcation request and the schedules we have

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set for this docket and Docket No. 09-035-15. As such, we will consider a party's request to vacate the Phase II schedule relating to the filing of rate design testimony and set a schedule for testimony filing and hearing dates at a future scheduling conference for Phase II.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission issues this Scheduling Order to govern

 - iii. After November 12, 2009, within seven (7) calendar days.
 - c. Phase II (Rate Design):
 - i. Until October 15, 2009, within 21 calendar days.
 - ii. Until December 1, 2009, within 14 calendar days.
 - iii. After December 1, 2009, within seven (7) calendar days.
- 3. Parties shall serve copies of all filings on other parties by electronic mail at or before the time an electronic copy of the document is filed with the Commission. Parties shall serve discovery requests and responses on applicable parties by electronic mail. In the event a document filed with the Commission or produced in response to a discovery request cannot reasonably be transmitted by electronic mail, the party filing the document shall file an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) to the Commission by hand delivery and shall serve an electronic copy of the document on CD (or, if an electronic copy is not available, a paper copy) on applicable parties by hand delivery if the parties being served is in the same metropolitan area as the serving party or by overnight courier if the party being served is located in a different metropolitan area from the serving party.
- 4. The Public Witness Hearings in the foregoing schedule shall begin at the time indicated and conclude at the ending time, or until individuals present at the ending time have

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finished their comments. The Commission may limit presentation of testimony or comments

that are unduly repetitious. Any individual wishing to present a statement of position to the

Commission that is unable to do so during the Public Witness Hearing may file a written
