Dear Commissioners,

This letter transmits the final Report of the Division of Public Utilities regarding the activities of Workgroups I and II that the Commission ordered the Division to organize in its Order dated February 18, 2010 in Docket No. 09-035-23 along with the Division's conclusions and recommendations. Generally, Workgroups I and II investigated (1) the reliability of PacifiCorp's sample load research data, and (2) the discrepancy between the sum of class and jurisdictional peak load forecasts. The participants in these two workgroups determined early on in the process to combine the two workgroups into one workgroup designated as "Workgroups I-II."

As explained in the Report, the Division recommends that the Commission issue an order to increase the Company's spending to accelerate the meter rotation program. Such an order will be necessary in order to assure that the accelerated meter rotation program is implemented.

Included with this Report are attached Appendices. Appendix A is independent comments from UIEC regarding the workgroups. Appendix B is independent comments from Rocky Mountain Power regarding the workgroups. Appendix C contains the initial issues lists circulated among the parties in the workgroups. Appendix D contains the slide shows the participants provided to the workgroups.

The Division thanks the participants in "Workgroups I-II" for their help and support. The meetings were well attended and presentations by the various participants were well prepared and constructive. The Division especially notes that this workgroup was one of the few it has



participated in which progress toward solutions seems to have been made and thanks again the parties for their efforts and goodwill.
