In response to the Commission's April 1, 2009 order declining Rocky Mountain Power's (the "Company") request for expedited treatment in the above referenced docket, the Company respectfully requests that should the Commission approve the insulation measure incentive changes proposed by the Company in this docket that the proposed incentives be granted an effective date of May 2, 2009. The Company's intent in requesting the originally filed April 1, 2009 effective date was to align with the effective date proposed by Questar Gas Company in Docket No. 09-057-T04, in which Questar proposed modifications to the insulation measure incentives offered through the ThermWise program. In this docket, the Commission approved the incentive levels proposed by Questar and ordered that they become effective on May 2, 2009. The Company believes that aligning the respective effective dates of the Rocky Mountain Power and Questar revised insulation incentive measures is beneficial to both customers and insulation contractors. As the Rocky Mountain Power and Questar programs are often used in conjunction with one another, a common effective date would minimize confusion among customers and contractors regarding the effective dates of the revised incentive levels of both programs.

The Company would also like to inform the Commission that a notification informing the public of the Company's proposed changes in this filing was posted on the Home Energy Savings Program website on March 27, 2009. The notification explains that the Company has filed to reduce incentives offered through the Home Energy Savings Program for insulation measures and provides a link to the Company's filing on the Commission's website.
