On April 7, 2009 PacifiCorp d/b/a Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") submitted Advice No. 09-05 regarding proposed modifications to Schedule 113 – Cool Cash Incentive Program. The proposed tariff modifications would change existing language defining incentive payment eligibility. Petitioner has requested an effective date of May 7, 2009, for these proposed changes in the tariff.

The Division of Public Utilities ("Division") filed a memorandum dated April 30, 2009, recommending the Commission suspend the proposed changes until the Company filed the required documentation of the cost benefit tests and the Division had sufficient time to review the completed filing. The Committee of Consumer Services ("Committee") also filed a memorandum on April 30, 2009, recommending specific wording changes to clarify the meaning of tariff.
