This filing is submitted in compliance with the Commission's Phase I Order on Revenue Requirement issued April 21, 2009 in Docket No. 08-035-38 implementing a \$45.0 million increase in annual revenue requirement. Proposed Schedule 98 applies a uniform percentage increase of 6.40 percent ordered by the commission to all tariff customers' bills as a line item for service. The 6.40 percent rate is the result of a 3.34 percent (\$45.0 million) increase applied to current rates including the current 2.96 percent Schedule 97 rider.

This filing will also revise Schedule 193 to reference the charges from Schedule 98, cancel Schedule 97 and revise the Index Sheet No. B.1A to eliminate Schedule 97 and add Schedule 98.
