Re: Request for New Report Due Date In the Matter of Rocky Mountain Power's Semi-Annual Demand Side Management Forecast Report – Docket No. 16-035-___

In its Order issued August 25, 2009 in Docket No. 09-035-T08, the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") approved the Phase I Stipulation ("Stipulation") file August 3, 2009. As specified in the Stipulation, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") is required to provide a Utah Demand Side Management ("DSM") tariff rider balancing account analysis to the Commission and Steering Committee on a semi-annual basis beginning November 1, 2009, similar to that originally provided by the Company in Advice No. 09-08 filed June 11, 2009 ("Semi-Annual Report"). The Semi-Annual Report is to include historical and projected monthly DSM expenditures, rate recovery and account balances; as well as, historical and projected monthly DSM expenditures by program, Schedule 193 revenue, and bill credits.

The Company respectfully requests that the annual due date of May 1st for the Semi-Annual Report be adjusted to July 1st annually, beginning in this 2016 calendar year. This will allow the Company to provide actual data for the first 5 months of a program year. The additional data will provide the Commission and DSM Steering Committee a more accurate look at projected expenditures, with time still available in the year to collaborate with the Steering Committee for any necessary changes to programs to better align expenditures and savings with the Company's savings targets and budget for the calendar year.

The Company discussed the new due date of July 1st with the Office of Consumer Services and the Division of Public Utilities, both of which do not oppose the request and believe will bring added value to the Semi-Annual Report.
