RECOMMENDATION (Suspension)

On or about June 11, 2009, Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed an application to modify the Demand Side management rider, Schedule 193, to collect an accrued account balance of approximately \$85 million. Two groups have requested intervention in the docket, Docket No. 09-035-T08, and raised a number of issues requesting, among other things, to suspend the proposed tariff. The Division of Public Utilities (Division) has reviewed the Company's application and the intervention requests. Based on its preliminary review, the Division recommends that the Commission suspend the Company's proposed tariff and convene a

scheduling conference, as soon as practicable, to allow interested parties appropriate time to investigate the issues and provide comments or testimony to the Commission.
