On August 6, 2009, the Commission issued its order in the above referenced docket. In that order, the Commission approved the Company’s proposed revisions to the Energy Star New Homes program and directed the Company to make the following modifications to the Schedule 110 tariff sheets. The Commission directed the Company to include language in the tariff which specifies that all compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) must be ENERGY STAR qualified to be eligible for incentives offered by the program. Also, the Commission ordered that the incentives approved in this docket shall be available for measures installed after July 24, 2009. Pursuant to the Commission’s order, the Company provides the attached tariff sheets for Schedule 110, which reflect the modifications discussed above.
