By The Commission:

On April 8, 2009, PacifiCorp submitted its ninth Integrated Resource Plan ("IRP") entitled "2008 Integrated Resource Plan" ("2008 IRP") to the Public Service Commission of Utah ("Commission") as required by our June 18, 1992, Order in Docket No. 90-2035-01, which promulgated our Standards and Guidelines governing PacifiCorp's IRP, and in accordance with our April x, 2009, order in this docket. The filing consists of a main document and a volume of appendices. Both documents are marked as drafts. In its cover letter, the Company states this version is not final or complete and will be modified with additional material prior to filing its final version which it would file with the Commission on May 29, 2009.

Pursuant to notice, we held a scheduling conference on April 14, 2009, and, based on the comments of parties, issue the following scheduling order wherein we invite interested parties to make comment on the appropriateness of the 2008 IRP and to make recommendations on whether the Commission should acknowledge the plan. Additionally, we invite comment from parties regarding the Company's proposed schedule for the filing of future IRP's.

1. The following schedule is set for this docket:

No later than Thursday, May 28, 2009	The Company shall file its wind integration study
Thursday, May 28, 2009	The Company shall file a redline version of its complete, final 2008 IRP. The Company shall file its proposed schedule and rationale for the filing dates of future IRP's.
Thursday, June 18, 2009	Comments due by all interested parties
Thursday, July 2, 2009	Reply comments due

2. Service of discovery information. Information exchanged between parties (discovery) shall be provided within two calendar weeks. Service of documents through electronic means between parties is encouraged to expedite receipt and exchange of materials. Parties may agree to a different response time than provided in this Scheduling Order.
