Dear Ms. Orchard:

Please find enclosed the original and five (5) copies, along with a compact disk, of PacifiCorp's 2008 Integrated Resource Plan ("2008 IRP"). Also enclosed is an original and five (5) copies of a redline version, which reflects changes made since the 2008 Draft IRP filed with Utah Public Service Commission (the "Commission") on April 8, 2009. Copies of the 2008 IRP are also available electronically on PacifiCorp's website, at www.pacificorp.com.

PacifiCorp submits the 2008 IRP to the Commission in compliance with its Standards and Guidelines for Integrated Resource Planning. Appendix C (pages 223 to 252) of this 2008 IRP contains tables that outline how PacifiCorp has addressed each of the procedural and substantive elements of the Commission's rules (see Tables C.1, C.2 and C.4 in "Appendix C - IRP Regulatory Compliance").

PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission acknowledge the 2008 IRP in accordance with its rules and fully support the 2008 IRP conclusions, including the proposed action plan.

The 2008 IRP is also submitted in compliance with the Commission's Request for Comments and Scheduling Order, dated April 27, 2009 in Docket No. 09-2035-01, which states:-

- The Company shall file its wind integration study no later than May 28, 2009 see Appendix F (pages 269 to 284) of this 2008 IRP.
- The Company shall file a redline version of its complete, final 2008 IRP no later than May 28, 2009 enclosed as a separate document with this 2008 IRP filing.
 Additional chapters to the draft include an Executive Summary, Appendix F Wind Integration Costs and Capacity Planning Contributions, Appendix G DSM Decrement Analysis, and Appendix H Additional Load and Resource Balance Information.

The requirement for the Company to file its proposed schedule and rationale for the filing dates of future IRP's will be provided as a separate submission to the Commission, no later than May 28, 2009.
