ISSUE:

On July 21, 2010, Mt. Wheeler Power Co. Inc (Mt. Wheeler) submitted to the Utah Public Service Commission (Commission) for acknowledgement, a Fourth Revised Sheet No. 60, Discontinuance, Restoration and Refusal of Service Rule 6.

RECOMMEND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

The Division recommends the Commission acknowledge Mt. Wheeler's Fourth Revised Sheet No. 60, Rule 6 with an effective date of July 13, 2010.

DISCUSSION:

Pursuant to Utah Code 54-7-12-(6), Mt. Wheeler's management has filed with the Commission, a revised Rule 6.

Mt. Wheeler's management has made changes in Rule 6 to address areas that have the potential to impact the distribution system in a negative manner and to better delineate customers responsibilities regarding the installation of electrical equipment and the affect it may have on the overall electrical distribution system.

Management indicates that many of these problems are caused by the installation of equipment and facilities with high fluctuating load characteristics which can impact the overall system harmonics as discussed in Section B of the Rule.

The Division recommends the Commission acknowledge Mt. Wheeler's revised Rule 6 and make it available for public inspection.
