PETITION FOR APPROVAL

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §§ 54-3-1, 54-4-1, 54-4-4 and 54-7-12, Rocky Mountain Power ("RMP" or the "Company") hereby petitions the Commission for an Order approving the one year Electric Service Agreement between Rocky Mountain Power and Kennecott Utah Copper LLC ("Kennecott") dated October 18, 2010, under which the Company will provide back up and supplemental electric service to Kennecott following termination of the parties' current contract on December 31, 2010. Rocky Mountain Power is filing the contract under seal and requests that the Commission protect the confidential information in the contract from disclosure.

1. Rocky Mountain Power is a division of PacifiCorp. PacifiCorp is an Oregon corporation that provides electric service to retail customers through its Rocky Mountain Power division in the states of Utah, Wyoming, and Idaho, and through its Pacific Power division in the states of Oregon, California, and Washington.

2. Rocky Mountain Power is a public utility in the state of Utah and is subject to the Commission's jurisdiction with respect to its prices and terms of electric service to retail customers in Utah. The Company serves approximately 770,000 customers and has approximately 2,400 employees in Utah. Rocky Mountain Power's principal place of business in Utah is 201 South Main Street, Suite 2300, Salt Lake City, Utah 84111.

The Company currently provides back-up and supplemental electric service to Kennecott through an Electric Service Agreement ("ESA") dated August 5, 2009. The ESA was approved by the Commission in a Report and Order dated November 25, 2009, in Docket No. 09-035-59. The ESA is scheduled to expire on December 31, 2010.

5. The Company and Kennecott have reached a settlement on a new ESA, and request that the Commission establish a schedule that will facilitate approval of that agreement prior to the expiration of the current contract. The terms of the contract require it to be confidential, so Rocky Mountain Power is filing the contract under seal, and requesting that the Commission protect the confidential information in the contract from disclosure. Any intervening parties will be asked to enter into a nondisclosure agreement in order to review the confidential information.

6. Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests that the Commission hold a scheduling conference expeditiously to provide adequate time for discovery, testimony and analysis by all interested parties and set this matter for hearing November 18, 2010. Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests that the Commission approve the attached ESA between the Company and Kennecott as establishing just and reasonable rates, terms and conditions for back-up and supplemental electric service to be supplied by RMP to Kennecott on and after January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011.

Requested Relief

7. Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests the Commission promptly set a scheduling conference and a hearing date that will enable the Commission to approve the ESA entered into by and between the Company and Kennecott as

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establishing rates and conditions for back-up and supplemental service to Kennecott that are just, reasonable and in the public interest.
