ISSUED: May 4, 2011

By The Commission:

On May 3, 2011, the Utah Rural Telecom Association ("URTA") filed a motion to dismiss the pole attachment issues from this proceeding and to strike the pertinent testimony of Jeffrey M. Kent and Steven R. McDougal, filed on behalf of PacifiCorp ("Company"), doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power. Alternatively, URTA urges the Commission to transfer the pole attachment issues from this docket to a rulemaking docket. URTA further requests the Commission to schedule URTA's motion for oral argument on five days written notice, but no later than May 12, 2011, citing Utah Administrative Code § R746-100-3H. URTA requests an expedited process and decision on its motion so that, if the motion is granted, URTA (as well as other interested parties) may avoid filing direct testimony on the pole attachment issues in this proceeding. That testimony is currently due on May 16, 2011.

The schedule for this proceeding was issued February 23, 2011. It is relatively complex and is the product of extensive discussion among the parties. It involves five overlapping phases. Its pace is dictated by the statutory mandate for a decision by September 21, 2011. Its structure was substantially influenced by the availabilities of expert witnesses and counsel, and parties' desires to stagger testimony filing deadlines.

Based on the foregoing considerations, the due date for filing written responses to URTA's motion is shortened to May 10, 2011. Oral arguments on the motion will be heard at 9:00 a.m., Thursday, May 12, 2011, Room 403, Heber M. Wells Bldg., 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.
