By The Commission:

This matter is before us on the motion of UIEC, filed May 11, 2011, to compel PacifiCorp ("Company"), doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power, to provide complete responses to certain data requests related to the preparation of UIEC's revenue requirement direct testimony. The motion also seeks an extended testimony filing deadline and expedited consideration. The Company has not yet filed a response to the motion. Under Commission rules, the Company's response is due in three days, on May 26, 2011, the same day UIEC's direct testimony on revenue requirement issues is due.

It is apparent the Commission will not be able to decide the merits of UIEC's motion until after the direct testimony due date. UIEC should therefore file its testimony on that date addressing the hedging and transmission-related cost issues referenced in its motion to the fullest extent possible. Depending on the outcome of the motion, a different remedy may be required than the day-for-day filing deadline extension requested. In its reply to the Company's response to the motion to compel, UIEC should describe the remedy it believes necessary, in the event the Commission grants UIEC's motion and compels the requested responses.
