On June 30, 2011, the UAE Intervention Group ("UAE") filed a motion requesting a one-week delay in the filing date for rebuttal testimony on cost of service, rate spread and rate design issues. Rebuttal testimony on these issues is currently due on Thursday, July 7, 2011.

In its motion, UAE represents based on preliminary settlement discussions among several parties (including Rocky Mountain Power, the Division of Public Utilities, the Office of Consumer Services, UAE and the Utah Industrial Energy Consumers, among others), there appears to be a reasonable likelihood that settlement can be reached on most or all rate spread, cost of service and rate design issues. UAE, having attempted to inform every party of its motion, states the foregoing parties do not object to the schedule change. Additionally, insofar as UAE has been able to determine, no party opposes its motion.

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Based on UAE's representations, the filing date for rebuttal testimony on cost of service, rate spread and rate design issues is hereby re-scheduled to July 14, 2011, in order to permit further settlement discussions among all interested parties on these issues.
