Re: Errata Filing In the Matter of the Application of Rocky Mountain Power for Approval of a Significant Energy Resource Decision Resulting from the All Source Request for Proposals, Docket No. 10-035-126

Dear Commissioners:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that reporting errors were discovered in the studies used to evaluate the Apex plant against a proxy planned resource, as part of Rocky Mountain Power's application for approval of CH2M Hill Lake Side 2 in this docket. The errors resulted in a change in the net present value revenue requirement of the Apex plant. Importantly, the studies were used *solely* to report the evaluation of the Apex plant and have <u>no</u> effect on the evaluation of any other request for proposal bid or benchmark, including the value reported for CH2M Hill Lake Side 2. These corrections also do not change the fact that Apex is largely unable to supply energy to Rocky Mountain Power customers until several transmission upgrades might be completed, which NV Energy and PacifiCorp Transmission estimated completion by 2016. Therefore, Apex is not an option in lieu of CH2M Hill Lake Side 2 to maintain reliable supply to Rocky Mountain Power customers well before 2016, regardless of any potential Apex economic benefits. In summary, these errors and corrections have no impact on the Company's application for approval of CH2MHill Lake Side 2.

Rocky Mountain Power is filing, concurrently with this letter, replacement pages 7 through 11 in the Confidential Testimony of Gregory N. Duvall, and Amended Exhibits 2.1 and 2.8 to the Confidential Testimony of Gregory N. Duvall. Rocky Mountain Power respectfully requests that the Commission and interested parties who have received the Confidential Testimony of Gregory N. Duvall including his exhibits, replace pages 7 through 11 and exhibits 2.1 and 2.8 of his testimony with those that are being filed today. To assist parties note the changes from the original Exhibits 2.1 and 2.8, Rocky Mountain Power provides, as part of Amended Exhibits 2.1 and 2.8, a table immediately following the cover of each exhibit which

indicates the materials that changed as a result of this filing. The changes in the body of the Confidential Testimony of Mr. Gregory N. Duvall are primarily dollar amounts.

Rocky Mountain Power is taking actions to ensure that the errors do not occur in the future, and hereby offers to hold a technical conference for the Commission and interested parties to assist with any questions regarding this errata filing.
