Based on discussions with the parties regarding this matter, the following schedule is set for the proceedings before the Review Board:

April 22, 2010 Tooele County must file their opposition to Rocky Mountain Power's Petition, if any, and any rebuttal testimony to the testimony filed by Rocky Mountain Power with its Petition, on or before April 22, 2010.

May 4, 2010 Rocky Mountain Power will file written surrebuttal testimony to Tooele County's April 22, 2010 rebuttal testimony if any is filed. The due date for this filing is May 4, 2010.

May 10, 11 and 12, 2010 A hearing on the matter will be held by the Review Board, beginning each day at 9:00 a.m. and concluding each day by 5:00 p.m., except Tuesday, May 11, 2010 when the hearing will conclude at 3:00 p.m. The hearings will be held in the Commission's Hearing Room 403, Fourth Floor of the Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

May 11, 2010 The Review Board will take public comment on this matter on May 11, 2010, from 4:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at the Tooele County Convention Center, located at the Deseret Peak Complex (2930 West Highway

112, Tooele County). In order to insure that as many members of the community are able to be heard as want to speak, the following limitations will be strictly enforced: (1) only residents of Tooele County will be allowed to speak during the Public Comment period; (2) each individual will be allowed to speak for only two minutes; and (3) individuals speaking will not be allowed to merely restate what has previously been heard by the Review Board. In lieu of attending this meeting and speaking, citizens of Tooele County can instead send e-mail comments to the Review Board at psccal@utah.gov.
