Approval of Standard Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement.

REQUEST

The Division requests that the Commission issue a scheduling order indicating that interested parties should respond to Rocky Mountain Power's application for approval of Standard Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement by May 25, 2010.

The Division also requests that the Company's original application and this notice of scheduling be distributed to a broad group including both those on telephone and electric standard service lists.

DISCUSSION

On or about April 27, 2010, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") an application for approval of a Standard Non-Reciprocal Pole Attachment Agreement ("Agreement"). On April 27, 2010, the Commission issued an Action Request to the Division seeking an explanation and statement of issues and a review of the proposed Agreement. The Division's response is due June 24, 2010.



A preliminary review of the proposed Agreements reveals several major changes that are likely to affect those seeking to attach equipment to the Company's poles. Therefore, the Division requests that the Commission issue a scheduling order requesting comments from interested parties by May 25, 2010. This will allow adequate time for Division staff to consider these comments and incorporate them into the Division's final analysis and recommendations by the June 24, 2010 deadline.
