Back-Up, Maintenance, and Supplementary Power

Supplemental Filing

On June 7, 2010, the Rocky Mountain Power (Company) filed proposed changes to the Availability paragraph on page one of Schedule 31, Back-up, Maintenance, and Supplementary Power. On June 23, 2010, the Division of Public Utilities filed comments with the Commission recommending approval of the proposed changes with minor changes in wording. Rocky Mountain Power has discussed the recommended languages changes with the DPU and is agreeable to those changes. Also on June 30, 2010, the Office of Consumer Services filed comments indicating no objections to the tariff language changes.

Rocky Mountain Power's original proposed language reads:

This Schedule is available to Customers who obtain any part of their usual or regular electric requirements from self-generation operating on a regular basis and who require Back-up or Maintenance Power from the Company not in excess of 10,000 kW.

As recommended by the DPU, the proposed language now reads:

This Schedule is available to Customers who obtain any part of their usual or regular electric requirements from self-generation operating on a regular basis and who require Supplementary and Back-up or Maintenance Power from the Company. The total of Back-up or Maintenance Power is not to exceed 10,000 kW.

Enclosed for filing are an original and two copies of proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.S.C.U No. 47 of PacifiCorp, d.b.a., Rocky Mountain Power, applicable to electric service in the State of Utah. Pursuant to the requirement of Rule R746-405D, PacifiCorp states that the proposed tariff sheets do not constitute a violation of state law or Commission rule. PacifiCorp will also provide an electronic version of this filing to there@utah.gov.
