## **ISSUE AND RECOMMENDATION**

On September 23, 2010, PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Rocky Mountain Power ("Company"), filed Advice Letter 10-10 ("Letter") requesting approval of changes to certain language in residential Schedules 1 and 3. In the Letter, the Company states that the intent of the changes "is to correct an oversight in the Application section of the current" schedules and "will reflect current billing practices for customers with multiple dwelling units."

After conversations with the Division, the Company filed a letter with the Commission on October 14, 2010, withdrawing the request to change the language in the schedules at this time indicating that it would continue its current billing practices, and would "include a proposal for this issue in the next general rate case." Unless otherwise directed by the Commission, given the Company's withdrawal of its request, the Division considers the Action Request closed at this time and will consider the Company's proposal in the next general rate case. Therefore, the Division recommends no further action on this matter at this time.
