RECOMMENDATION

The Division recommends that the Commission approve the Company's request to correct the power charge for Schedule 10 customers not participating in the time-of-day program.

DISCUSSION

On December 8, 2010, Rocky Mountain Power ("Company") filed with the Commission a letter requesting to correct the power charge as listed in the approved tariff for Schedule 10 customers not participating in the time-of-day program. The tariff currently indicates that the power charge is \$5.57 per kW. The Company requests that this be changed to \$5.75 per kW to reflect the Commission's order in Docket 09-035-23. The Company indicates that it has been using this higher amount in billing Schedule 10 customers since June 8, 2010.

The Division has reviewed the Commission's order in Docket No. 09-035-23, "Rocky Mountain Power 2009 General Rate Case Phase II Order on Rate Design," dated June 2, 2010. In that order, the Commission adopted a settlement stipulation ("Stipulation") on non-residential rate design, which is attached to the order. At page 47 of the Commission's order, the Stipulation indicates that power charge, All On-Season kW, for non-participating Schedule 10



customers is \$5.75. Therefore, the Division recommends that the Commission approve the requested correction.
