The purpose of this filing is to propose a reduction to the Schedule 193 (the “DSM Tariff Rider”) collection rate.

Dear Messieurs Lively and Solander:

On December 9, 2010, PacifiCorp, doing business in Utah as Rocky Mountain Power, (“Company”) filed proposed tariff sheets to reduce the collection rate currently applied to the Demand-side Management (“DSM”) tariff rider, Schedule 193. The current DSM tariff rider is approximately 4.6 percent of customer bills. The Company proposes to reduce the collection rate to approximately 3.7 percent of customers bills effective January 1, 2011. Also on December 9, 2010, the Commission issued an Action Request to the Utah Division of Public Utilities (“Division”) to review and provide recommendations regarding the proposed rate change by December 23, 2010. On December 15, 2010, the Company filed a revised sheet for Schedule 193 to make two corrections. The revised sheet includes 1) previously omitted references to Schedules 40, 97 and 98, and 2) a corrected symbol required pursuant to R746-405-2(3).

On December 14, 2010, the Office of Consumer Services (“Office”) filed comments with the Commission recommending approval of the proposed Schedule 193 collection rates, effective January 1, 2011. On December 21, the Division filed comments with the Commission recommending approval of the proposed 193 collection rates and revised tariff sheet, effective January 1, 2011.

Based on the recommendations of the Division and Office, the Commission approves the Company's request to reduce the DSM tariff rider as filed on December 15, with an effective date of January 1, 2011.
