On January 20, 2011, both the Division of Public Utilities (the “Division”) and the Office of Consumer Services (the “Office”) filed comments with the Public Service Commission of Utah (the “Commission”) concerning Rocky Mountain Power’s (the “Company”) Tariff Advice No. 10-14, which was filed on December 28, 2010 and subsequently assigned to the above referenced docket. Through Tariff Advice No. 10-14, the Company proposed administrative changes to the Energy Star New Homes program tariff (Electric Service Schedule No. 110).

Following the submittal of Tariff Advice No. 10-14, the Company engaged in discussions with both the Division and Office, the content of which are detailed in their respective comments to the Commission. In their comments, both the Division and Office propose modifications to the proposed tariffs submitted by the Company in Tariff Advice No. 10-14. The Division provided as an attachment to their comments Schedule 110 tariff sheets marked in redline form to identify tariff language modifications discussed between the parties. The Company has reviewed and agrees with the tariff language changes as proposed by the Division and Office. For the convenience of the Commission, the Company has compiled the tariff language changes proposed by the Division and Office into one set of tariff sheets and is providing these as an attachment to this letter with language modifications from what was originally filed in Tariff Advice No. 10-14 marked in redline form.
