Stress Factor Study Results in Compliance with Stipulation in Rocky Mountain
Power 2012 General Rate Case

As part of the stipulation in the above referenced docket (“Stipulation”), Rocky Mountain Power agreed to conduct a new Stress Factor study prior to filing its next general rate case. Paragraph 55 from the Stipulation states:

55. For purpose of Utah cost of service studies, the Company agrees to propose a plan for a new Stress Factor study by July 1, 2013 and to request that the Commission hold a technical conference to review the plan and take comments from interested parties. The Company’s study plan shall be shared with intervenors to the current docket no later than two weeks prior to the scheduled technical conference. The Company shall provide the completed study to intervenors in the current case at least two months before its next general rate case.

In compliance with the paragraph above, the Company submitted its proposed Stress Factor Study Plan on July 1, 2013, and a technical conference to discuss the proposed plan was held August 14, 2013. Rocky Mountain Power now submits the results of the Stress Factor Study. Based on the comments at the technical conference, the Company is including additional historical data in parts 1 through 3, and an additional part 6 that includes information on loss of load probability and energy not served from the 2013 Integrated Resource Plan. Enclosed are two CDs containing the confidential and non-confidential electronic copies of the study plan, assumptions, study results, and workpapers in the file formats in which they were created.

The Company will also provide an electronic version of the non-confidential sections of the filing to psc@utah.gov.
