Definitions

Environmental Attributes (“Green Tags”). Environmental Attributes are the Green Tags associated with the production of kilowatt-hours from a motive force that is wind, solar, biomass, CHP, small hydro and other motive forces considered “renewable” under the laws of any state where PacifiCorp can or does sell such Green Tags into the compliance market or voluntary market.

Energy Efficiency Credits (“White Tags®”). Energy Efficiency Credits are the White Tags® associated with any energy efficiency measure as defined by the laws of any state into which PacifiCorp may sell such White Tags® into the compliance market or voluntary market.

UIEC REQUEST 12-1:

Please state for each month the amount of energy for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 in megawatt-hours produced by Rocky Mountain Power (“RMP”) or acquired by RMP under contract where RMP claims to own the Green Tags associated with the production of the energy.

UIEC REQUEST 12-2:

Please state for each month the parasitic load for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 in megawatt-hours of each energy production facility owned by RMP that contributes to your answer to the previous request.

UIEC REQUEST 12-3:

Please state for each month the parasitic load for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 of each energy production facility under contract to RMP where RMP contends that it owns the Green Tags associated with the energy production of the facility.

UIEC REQUEST 12-4:

Of the Green Tags owned or acquired by RMP, please state for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 the quantity sold in megawatt-hours by RMP and the quantity retained in megawatt hours.

UIEC REQUEST 12-5:

Please provide by month for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 the revenue received for the sales that are the subject of the previous request.

UIEC REQUEST 12-6:

Does RMP contend that the Green Tags generated by its own production or acquired by contract from energy producers have a limited life? If so, please describe the limited life and the source of RMP's position on the limited life.

UIEC REQUEST 12-7:

What is RMP's policy of disposing of Green Tags for value before their expiration if RMP contends they expire?

UIEC REQUEST 12-8:

Does RMP maintain a "bank" of the Green Tags? If so, please describe (a) how the accounting is maintained, (b) the current balance in the bank of unsold Green Tags associated with energy acquired or produced by RMP from resources capable of generating power for which the Green Tags are marketable to anyone, and/or (c) the current balance in the bank of unsold Green Tags acquired by contract from RMP and the parasitic load of those facilities.

Please state for each month for 2009 and for each month year-to-date for 2010 in megawatt-hours the White Tags® created or acquired by RMP.

UIEC REQUEST 12-9:

Of the White Tags® created or acquired by RMP, for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 the quantity sold in megawatt-hours by RMP and the quantity retained in megawatt hours?

UIEC REQUEST 12-10:

Please provide by month for each month for 2009 and each month year-to-date for 2010 the revenue received for the sales that are the subject of the previous request.

UIEC REQUEST 12-11:

Does RMP contend that White Tags® have a limited life? If so, please describe the limited life and the source of RMP's position on the limited life.

UIEC REQUEST 12-12:

What is RMP's policy of disposing of White Tags® for value before their expiration if RMP contends they expire?

UIEC REQUEST 12-13:

Does RMP maintain a "bank" of White Tags®? If so, please state in megawatt-hours the current balance in the bank of White Tags®.


