Pursuant to the discussion and agreements reached at the scheduling conference held October 13, 2011, in this matter, the Commission establishes the following schedule:

Monday, November 28, 2011	Filing date for Independent Evaluator's report on the RFP
Wednesday, December 7, 2011	Filing date for Reply Comments
Monday, December 12, 2011	Hearing The hearing in this matter will begin on December 12, 2011, at 9:00 a.m., in Fourth Floor Room 403, Heber M. Wells Building, 160 East 300 South, Salt Lake City, Utah.

The application for approval of a solicitation process which is the subject of this docket was filed on October 5, 2011. Utah Code Ann. § 54-17-201(2)(f) requires Commission action on the application within 60 days of that date, unless the Commission determines additional time to analyze the proposed solicitation process is warranted and in the public interest. The parties have agreed upon a schedule which is incompatible with the statutory

deadline in order to permit the requisite level of analysis. We find the deviation from the statutory time for review to be warranted in this case and in the public interest.
